Chronic infections represent a major cause of human cancer, accounting for up to 13% of all cancer diagnoses.

Cancer cases, as complications of *Helicobacter pylori* (Hp), hepatitis C virus (HCV) and human papillomavirus (HPV) infection, account for 75% of the reported cancer cases linked to chronic infections.

Regular work health checks provide an opportunity for early detection of infections.

Cancer Prevention at Work is an EU-funded project developing and implementing new surveillance protocols targeting infection-related cancers in occupational health promotion programs.
